About A Port in the Storm

A Port in the Storm is a non-profit organization that offers affordable accommodations for adults from rural and northern areas while they receive treatment in Winnipeg.

We also welcome family and friends who accompany individuals staying in the hospital.

Our staff provide a warm, supportive and compassionate environment so you can focus on what is most important – getting the care you need. While you are with us you are more than a guest; you are family.

Our Accommodations

Our one bedroom, fully-furnished suites are located in a secure building convenient to both Health Sciences Centre and St. Boniface Hospital. Each suite includes a full kitchen and bathroom, living room and dining area.

Other amenities include TV, phone, Wi-Fi, parking and free use of the laundry facility.

Our Rates

Suites are \$58 per night for self-paid, \$75 per night for third party billing with a \$32 cleaning fee at the end of your stay.

Meals

Meals can be pre-arranged with various third party options. Please inquire at the office for these options.

Reservations

To make your first reservation at *A Port in the Storm* a referral from a medical health care professional is required. Referral forms can be found on our website (under "Accommodations"), or can be requested by fax, email or phone.

Reservations must be made 24 hours in advance of your stay.

Cancellation Policy

A Port in the Storm requires 48 hours notice to cancel your reservation. For cancellations made with less than 48 hours notice you will be charged \$58.

During Your Stay

A Port in the Storm is a tobacco, alcohol and scent-free environment.

Your comfort and safety is our main concern. As *A Port in the Storm* is not a medical facility a caregiver is required to accompany you throughout your stay if you are unable to care for yourself.

During your stay at *A Port in the Storm*, you are responsible for cleaning and caring for your room. Cleaning supplies may be borrowed from the office.

Children under 18 are welcome to stay at *A Port in the Storm* but must be supervised by an adult at all times.
